- 4. It was mentioned "Pain that is not transformed is transmitted." What does this mean to you?

- 5. Verse 2 says, "Fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer & perfecter of faith For the joy set before him he endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God." Why is it so important to keep our eyes on Jesus is light of the previous verse?
- 6. What does "The Cross before the Crown" mean to you?
